WELCOME OUR NEW GAP PASTOR



Effective **April 16, 2024** we welcome Rev. Dr. Jon M. Fancher as our new Gap Pastor replacing Rev. Bill Hudson upon his resignation effective April 15th, 2024.

As we have completed most of our transitional work, Parma-South does not require another transitional pastor. Rev. Fancher's key job elements are: preach at our worship services; oversee church operations; provide committee support; moderate Session meetings. and most importantly, promote a vision of hope and promise for the congregation in anticipation of the arrival of Parma-South's next called pastor.

Rev. Fancher is Pastor Emeritus of Rocky River Presbyterian Church where he served from 1991 until his retirement in 2022. Jon and his wife Mary were married in 1997 at Parma-South. Mary is the daughter of Rev. Bob Bates, our Associate Pastor from 1968 to 1984. Rev. Jon comes to us with a number of Parma-South connections and we are blessed to have his leadership at this time in our transitional process.

MEMORIAL DAY SERVICE

Parma-South has been the site of Memorial Day Services since 1867. We are recognized as having the longest continuing Memorial Day Services in the State of Ohio. We are pleased to work with the City of Parma Heights again as we host this 157th service on Monday, May 27th. The service begins at 9:30 AM on our front lawn. Your church Fellowship Committee will again provide bottled water and donuts for those attending.



The Sanctuary will be open to the community, and church members will be at the doors to greet visitors.



The service will be led by our pastor and American Legion Post 703. It will include a welcome by Mayor Gallo, singing of patriotic hymns, music by the Valley Forge Marching Band, and brief messages from two local veterans. The thirty minute service will be followed with a parade on Pearl Road to the Parma Heights Cemetery, where departed veterans will be honored.
